- Copy of all 2020 Federal Income Tax Returns and W-2 forms for student (if applicable) and parent(s).
- Social Security numbers for parent and student or if the student is not a U.S. Citizen, Alien Registration number or documentation as U.S. Permanent Residents or U.S. Citizens.
- Records of balances in checking and savings for student and parent(s).
- Marital Status of parent(s) and date of marital status (for example, the date of marriage).
- Student Driver's License # (if applicable).

Create their User ID and Password by going to <u>https://fsaid.ed.gov</u> and create the two ID's, one for the student and one for a parent.

The students will use their login to access the FAFSA at <u>www.FAFSA.gov</u>, the parent will use their ID to link to IRS and to sign the FAFSA.
